To the General Public

In the interests of safety please keep out of the horse walks and the Collecting Rings which have all been signed. Crossing points have been provided across the horse walks at regular intervals.

To Owners / Exhibitors / Riders / Competitors

Due to the rigid safety regulations laid down by the Health and Safety Executive, you are strongly requested to take great care when moving horses on the Showground and remain within designated horse areas. Competitors who fail to do so may be asked to leave the Showground.

Grooms and other helpers other than the person leading the horse or pony who fail to comply with stewards requests to leave the horse walk may be subject to disqualification.

DOGS TO BE KEPT ON LEADS AT ALL TIMES

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Postal Entry forms for all classes must be completed by the owner or representative and sent to the Entry Secretary: Carol Brougham, 11 Meadow Road, Weaverham, Northwich, Cheshire, CW8 3BS. Entries on the day will be taken (**please see schedule for eligible classes**). **Entries will be taken on the day with a surcharge of £5 and £10 for RIHS Qualifying classes.**
2. SHOWJUMPING ENTRIES now accepted before the day. BRITISH SHOWJUMPING entries will also be taken on the day. **British Showjumping Exhibits Only** - In the event of insufficient entries Rule 76.6 will be adhered to in all classes.
3. Cheques must be made payable to The Cheshire Horse Show Ltd. ALL COMPETITOR NUMBERS TO BE COLLECTED ON SHOW DAY
4. Owners may enter as many horses as they wish, and all competitors are open unless stated otherwise in the schedule.
5. Entries will **NOT BE ACCEPTED** unless accompanied by the correct fees (and must include first aid tariff of £4 per competitor).
6. Under no circumstances will entries be changed, substituted or amended once received. Any entries received after the closing date will be subject to the additional fee. Entries will only be accepted on the official entry form.
7. In the event of a horse or pony being unable to compete through illness, accident or the like, the Society will refund the whole of the entry fee on production of a Veterinary Certificate, (**except in the case of British Showjumping exhibits, which are provided for under British Showjumping rules – please refer to British Showjumping rule book**).
8. Exhibitor's boxes and Exhibits must stand in the space allocated for their purposes. The Society will strictly enforce this condition.
9. Entries to be on showground half an hour before judging.
10. **ALL PRIZE MONEY MUST BE COLLECTED ON THE DAY OF THE SHOW OTHERWISE IT WILL BE FORFEITED.** No prize money will be given out without production of the Exhibitors number, rosette and class number. Prize money will be awarded once results received by Treasurer.
11. All trophies must be returned in good condition at least one month prior to the date of the next Show.
12. Hats: A 'Riding Hat', designed to provide protection, must be worn, at all times when mounted by anyone, whether or not a Competitor, at a British Showjumping competition. Harnesses must be properly adjusted and fastened at all times when mounted.

When jumping, including warming up, all Competitors must wear 'Protective Headwear' i.e. a hat which meets one of the following standards:

British - All PAS 015, VG1 - Provided they are BSI Kitemarked.

European – VG1 – Provided they are BSI Kitemarked

ALL RIDDEN CLASS COMPETITORS must wear a hard hat to the current BSI and EU standard unless they are competing in Classes 72, 73, 76 or 122 - 125 **and** have signed a Hat Waiver Form requested from Secretary or downloaded from www.thecheshirehorseshow.co.uk.

13. It is recommended that competitors involved in jumping wear a body protector of the appropriate BSI and EU standard.
14. A levy of £4.00 will be charged per competitor towards the cost of First Aid provision.
15. In Light horse classes (excluding qualifying classes) where there are less than 6 entries, prize money will be awarded to 1st place only. Rosettes to 5th place will be awarded (some Showjumping to 7th place).
16. NO REFUND OF ENTRIES WILL BE GIVEN, except in the event of unforeseen cancellation of the show, when a £5.00 levy will be deducted from each entry to cover Administration costs.

RIDDEN SHOW HUNTER HORSE CLASSES – Ring 1

This show is affiliated to the Sport Horse Breeding (GB). All horses must be on the basic register of SHB (GB) for classes 10 - 16. **Riders and owners must be current members of Sport Horse (GB).** In classes 11-16 all horses also have to be on the 2019 (SHB(GB)) show hunter register. Classes 11-16 are RIHS qualifiers (entries will include an RIHS levy of £9.50) and in classes 11-16 the first two in each class will qualify. In classes 15 & 16 In the Lightweight section, the two highest placed smalls and the two highest placed lightweights will qualify and in the Heavyweight section the two highest placed middleweights and the two highest placed heavyweights will qualify. **Day Ticket = £36** (this entitles competitors to compete at a maximum of 2 show's in the year at £36 per show – it covers owner and rider membership together with horse registration for that show). If the class is a qualifying class for RIHS, in order for the qualification to be valid, application for full owner/rider membership and horse registration must be received in the SHB(GB) office within 14 days. **It is strongly recommended that competitors aged 18 or over wear Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the following current Safety Standards: All PAS 015; VG1, (BS) EN1384 20170, ASTM F1163 04a onwards; SNELL E2001; AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards. It is mandatory for competitors under the age of 18 to wear such skull caps or hats. In the jumping phase of working hunter classes the aforementioned skull caps/riding hats must be worn.**

This show is affiliated to **Ponies Association (UK) (Affiliation Number 19/A18/8239).** **PONIES (UK) GOLD MEDAL SERIES** - Classes 12 – 16 are qualifiers for the Gold Medal Series at the 2019 Ponies (UK) Summer Classic, Equifest 2019 and BSPA 2019. **The 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each qualifying class will qualify.** Qualification cards will not be awarded in the ring however placings will be confirmed by results sent in by the show secretary.

This show is affiliated to the **NCPA (Affiliation Number 103/19)** and is a qualifier for the **NCPA Pony of the Year Show** in September 2019. 1st & 2nd prizewinners in Class 10 will qualify.

Special Prizes: *The Lord Daresbury Perpetual Challenge Cup will be awarded to the champion Hunter.*

Judge **Ride – MR J COOKSON, Cheshire** **Conformation - MRS P POWLEY, Cheshire**

Class 10 **Novice Hunters - NCPA Qualifier** - Mare or gelding 4 years or over not having awarded a first prize value of £60 or total of £200 (or equivalent values) in any SHB(GB) affiliated Ridden Hunter Classes at home or abroad before 1st January in current year, excepting all prize money awarded as a four year old. Any horse that qualifies for HOYS in a Ridden Hunter Class will not be eligible to compete in Novice classes from 1st January the following year but horses that qualified for HOYS as a 4 year old are exempt.

The Polly Coles 4 & 5 Year Old Ridden Hunter Championship – The top three 4 or 5 year olds in any SHB(GB) Novice Ridden Hunter Class, held at shows prior to the 2019 Hunter Show will qualify. Qualification will not pass down the line. At the final to be held at the SHB(GB) National Hunter Supreme Championship Show the highest placed 4 & 5 year old will each receive £1000. At the Championship 4 & 5 year olds will be judged separately.

- Class 11 **Small Hunter RIHS Qualifier** - Mare or gelding 4 years or over, exceeding 148cms but not to exceed 158cms. Riders to have attained their 16th birthday by 1st January in the current year.
- Class 12 **Lightweight Hunter RIHS Qualifier** - Mare or gelding 4 years or over, exceeding 158cms, capable of carrying up to 12.7 stone. Riders to have attained their 16th birthday by 1st January in the current year.
- Class 13 **Middleweight Hunter RIHS Qualifier** - Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 158cms, capable of carrying 12.7 stone but not 14 stone. Riders to have attained 16th birthday by 1st January in the current year.
- Class 14 **Heavyweight Hunter RIHS Qualifier** - Mare or gelding 4 years and over, exceeding 158cms and capable of carrying over 14 stone. Riders to have attained their 16th birthday by 1st January in the current year.

Championship: The Horses placed first and second in Classes 11 - 14 are eligible to go forward to the championship.

Championship to take place after Class 14.

- Class 15 **Amateur Ridden Hunter – Lightweight RIHS Qualifier** - Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over, capable of carrying 12.7 stone and under. Small Hunters to be included in this category.
- Class 16 **Amateur Ridden Hunter – Heavyweight RIHS Qualifier** - Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over, capable of carrying over 12.7 stone. Middleweight Hunters to be included in this category.

AMATEUR HUNTER CHAMPIONSHIP - The Horses placed first and second in Classes 15 & 16 are eligible to go forward to the championship.

Championship to take place after Class 16.

HACK CLASSES – Ring 4

This Show is Affiliated to the British Show Horse Association (BSHA). **RIHS Qualifying Classes** are held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association (BSHA). Horses must be registered with the Association and all Owners, Exhibitors and Riders must be Association Members. Riders must be 15 years of age or older. **Registration numbers must be quoted on entry form.** Classes 18 and 19 are qualifiers for The Royal International Horse Show. The first prize winner will qualify to compete at the final. If already qualified the second will qualify, if the first and second are already qualified then third will go forward. **Horses competing at the RIHS and qualifying shows in Hunter Sections of The Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain at their Affiliated Shows cannot compete in Hack, Cobs and Riding Horse classes at the same show, on the same day and vice versa.** This does not apply to SHB (GB) Ridden Sport Horse classes.

The three highest placed prize winners in all **Open** affiliated classes will qualify to compete in the BSHA Classic Supreme Classes at the National Championship Show September 2019.

The BSHA offer a Novice, Young Rider and Amateur rosette in each Open class and a Champion rosette for each section (with the exception of Open Working Show Horse, Ladies Show Horse & HOYS Hunter classes).

DAY TICKETS - Non-Members may purchase up to a maximum of 2 Day Tickets per Exhibitor, per Horse, per Rider, per season. A Day Ticket will allow entry into Amateur, Home Produced, In-Hand, Novice, Working, Young Rider and Open Affiliated classes only, **but will NOT allow entry into RIHS or HOYS qualifying classes.** Horses registered on a Day Ticket do not require a JMB height certificate. Competitors can apply for a Day Ticket by downloading an application form, or apply online on the BSHA website.

PLEASE NOTE: To comply with BSHA Rules (unless competing on a Day Ticket), all **ON THE DAY** entries **MUST** show proof of current BSHA Membership before entry is accepted.

Judge **Ride – MRS M MACLENNAN, Lancashire** **Conformation – MRS X BARKER-WILD, Lancashire**

Class 17 **Novice Hack** - Mare or gelding 4 years or over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 160cms. Not won a first prize of £35 or more, or more than a total of £250 (including Championship Prize Money) in any showing classes excluding Working Show Horses, Best Trained, Pairs, Side Saddle or In-Hand classes that were Affiliated to the Association, at home or abroad, prior to 1st January in the current year. See Rule 7E. BSHA Rule Book 2019. Exhibitors in this class can compete on a Day Ticket (Competitors can apply for a Day Ticket by downloading an application form from the BSHA website).

Class 18 **Small Hack RIHS Qualifier** - Mare or gelding 4 years or over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 154cms.

Class 19 **Large Hack RIHS Qualifier** - Mare or gelding 4 years or over, exceeding 154cms but not exceeding 160cms.

Class 20 **Amateur Owner Rider/Home Produced Hack** - Mare or gelding 4 years or over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 160cms. Open to Horses, which are either stabled at home or in a DIY yard and which since 1st January in the current year, have not been shown by a Professional during the current season or stabled in a Professional yard at any time in the current year. To be ridden by an Amateur – see Rule 7A-C in BSHA 2019 Rulebook. Exhibitors in this class can compete on a Day Ticket (Competitors can apply for a Day Ticket by downloading an application form from the BSHA website).

Championship: *The horses placed 1st and 2nd in Classes 17 - 20 are eligible to go through to the Championship.*

RIDING HORSE CLASSES – Ring 4

This Show is Affiliated to the British Show Horse Association (BSHA). RIHS qualifying classes are held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Horses must be registered with the Association and all owners, exhibitors and riders must be Association Members. Riders must be 15 years of age or older. **Registration numbers must be quoted on entry form.** Classes 22 and 23 are qualifiers for The Royal International Horse Show. The first prize winner will qualify to compete at the final. If already qualified the second will qualify, if the first and second are already qualified then third will go forward. Horses competing at the RIHS and qualifying shows in Hunter Sections of The Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain at their Affiliated Shows cannot compete in Hack, Cobs and Riding Horse classes at the same show, on the same day and vice versa. This does not apply to SHB (GB) Ridden Sport Horse classes.

The three highest placed prize winners in all **Open** affiliated classes will qualify to compete in the BSHA Classic Supreme Classes at the National Championship Show in September 2019. The BSHA offer a Novice, Young Rider and Amateur rosette in each Open class and a Champion rosette for each section.

DAY TICKETS - Non-Members may purchase up to a maximum of 2 Day Tickets per Exhibitor, per Horse, per Rider, per season. A Day Ticket will allow entry into Amateur, Home Produced, In-Hand, Novice, Working, Young Rider and Open Affiliated classes only, **but will NOT allow entry into RIHS or HOYS qualifying classes.** Horses registered on a Day Ticket do not require a JMB height certificate. Competitors can apply for a Day Ticket by downloading an application form, or apply online on the BSHA website.

Not won a first prize of £35 or more, or more than a total of £250 (including Championship Prize Money) in any showing classes excluding Working Show Horses, Best Trained, Pairs, Side Saddle or In-Hand classes that were Affiliated to the Association, at home or abroad, prior to 1st January in the current year. See Rule 7E. BSHA Rule Book 2019 Exhibitors in this class can compete on a Day Ticket (Competitors can apply for a Day Ticket by downloading

an application form from the BSHA website).

- Class 22 **Small Riding Horse RIHS Qualifier** - Mare or gelding 4 years or over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms.
- Class 23 **Large Riding Horse RIHS Qualifier** - Mare or gelding 4 years or over, exceeding 158cms.
- Class 24 **Amateur Owner Rider/Home Produced Riding Horse** - Mare or gelding 4 years or over, exceeding 148cms. DAY TICKETS - Non-Members may purchase up to a maximum of 2 Day Tickets per Exhibitor, per Horse, per Rider, per season. A Day Ticket will allow entry into Amateur, Home Produced, In-Hand, Novice, Working, Young Rider and Open Affiliated classes only, **but will NOT allow entry into RIHS or HOYS qualifying classes.** Horses registered on a Day Ticket do not require a JMB height certificate. Class 132 **Pleasure Driving Class** - Pleasure Driving Classes are for newcomers to showing and not intended for those who show in private driving classes. Regular showing competitors are asked to respect this and entries for the pleasure driving class will not be accepted from those who enter our private driving class. To be judged 15% vehicle suitability, fit and cleanliness, 15% harness suitability, fit and cleanliness, 70% driver and groom, horse/pony way of going and suitability as a family pleasure animal. Competitors may be required to drive and halt between two pairs of cones and execute a U-turn in their individual show. This class will be split into two sections;

Section 1 – Non Pneumatics tyres

Section 2 – Pneumatics tyres specially designed for carriages (i.e. not car tyres)

Class 133 **Exercise Vehicle Class** - 2 or 4 wheeled. Open to horses and ponies, any height. A single, pair or tandem driven to a carriage of non-traditional type design and includes those with pneumatic tyres specially designed for carriages (i.e. not car tyres). Lamps need not be carried. Judging will include general cleanliness, safety of turnout, correct fitting of harness and vehicle suitability.

The Roger Sutton Memorial Trophy - This class can also be entered as part of a joint competition with The

Royal Cheshire County Show held at Clay House Farm, Knutsford on 18th & 19th June 2019 in memory of Roger Sutton who so enjoyed private driving in Cheshire. To be eligible for the trophy, **competitors must enter the Exercise Vehicle class at both shows and enter both Shows by 22 May**. Points will be awarded at both shows (1st - 5 points, 2nd - 4 points, 3rd – 3 points, 4th – 2 points, competing but unplaced - 1 point) and the competitor with the highest amalgamated points will be awarded the Roger Sutton Memorial Trophy, sash and £100, the competitor placed 2nd will be awarded a rosette and £50. In the event of a tie there will be a drive off following the class at The Royal Cheshire County Show. The judge of the drive off may not necessarily be a BDS judge.
